Our Journey Together

This article is a calling to you, Child of God. And it's about your journey. A simple statement, probably very well known within you but worth bringing up just the same.

The topic is relationships. As I reflect

on Unity Chapel, the community that has been built and we are continuing to build, I believe we have derived the perfect venue for the journey of our spiritual awakening—for each one of us. After all, that's why we're here, isn't it? Are you after a deeper sense of your connection with God? Are you after a deeper sense of love and peace and happiness in your life? Do you see these happening hand in hand? Then I think you are on the right track. And in the right place to do just that. That's what the Unity movement is for. And that's what Unity Chapel is for too!

Relationship is at the foundation of our awakening to God. All of our relationships in life have the opportunity to support this purpose. For it is through these relationships we learn about God's Love, and the means to experience and express this—and to extend this. We have the opportunity to declare this within Unity Chapel, and we would not be far off from Jesus' teachings. Within our community we can see this as a means to move toward this awakening in our lives. Stated simply, it is through relationship with one another we are able to discover our ways of sharing love. Perhaps too we can learn in these relationships those matters that can block us from experiencing the love of God.

We might be asking ourselves how to explore both sides of this question? The way you think of another reflects your thinking. This is how you learn about yourself and your belief systems. This is also how you can accept those thoughts or recognize a change is called for. Well where does that change occur to be truly meaningful and effective? You know the answer to that. Change your thinking, change your life.

Think of those who you have found in our community. Recognize they are there by divine appointment, as are you. For it is through them, more specifically, your reaction to them, that you can learn about yourself. This can be the means by which we learn of decisions, or beliefs that we carry. Beliefs that, while seemingly keeping us safe, block us from truly knowing another person, block us from accepting another. And they can block us from knowing who we truly are as God's extension.

"When two or three are gathered in my name, there I am, in the midst of them" (Mt. 18:20). That "there I am" refers to the Christ consciousness that we all share, whether known or not. We are gathered in Unity to awaken to the Christ within us. And our forum to achieve this is through our relationship with one another. Everyone you meet who spends time at Unity Chapel has that express purpose, whether they (and you) know it or not.

Let your relationship with everyone here be recognized as such. For you can see them as an opportunity to discover your thoughts and beliefs. You are using this to chart the course of your life; your course of awakening to your own wholeness, your divinity.

I am thoroughly convinced Jesus saw everyone as they were created. As the Holy Divine Extension of God. Regardless of how they operated in their lives; in their time then, as well as today. Perhaps we're not there, but we can hold that as an ideal, and intention on our part. "Very truly, I tell you, one who believes in me will also do the works that I do and, in fact, will do greater works..." (Jn 14:12). Each time we take the opportunity to do this, we are able to forgo or forgive a thought held previously about them. We are also able to question decisions we have made in our thinking.

Let those opportunities be the doorway to a new experience of Love in your life. Perhaps we can use this setting of Unity Chapel to pursue this insight amongst our brothers and sisters in our community. We do this, and we're going to need more seats!

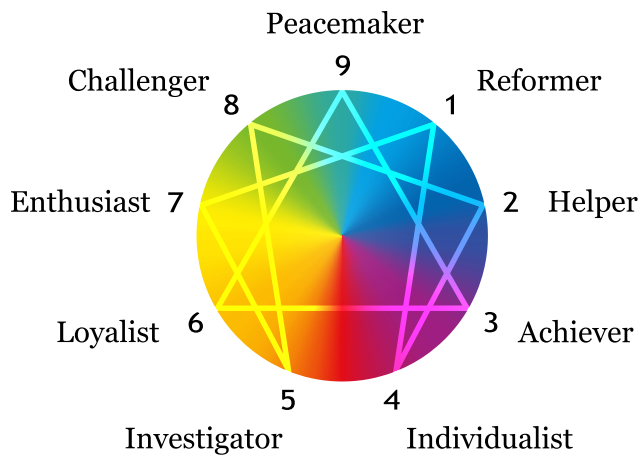

Enneagram Class

The enneagram has become a widely accepted tool enabling each of us to identify our own personality traits and styles of operating in our lives. Are you a Reformer, a Helper, an Achiever, an Individualist, an Investigator, a Loyalist, an Enthusiast, a Challenger, a Peacemaker? Learning that your personality fits one of these types brings clarity about yourself and others in your life. We will be using Enneagram tools to deepen our understanding of these personality traits, and the means to more effectively work with your style, as well as other personality styles.

Originally developed in Sufi Mysticism, the noted Russian psychologist and mystic, G. I. Gurdjieff developed the concept of the

Enneagram system into a powerful tool in the field of psychology. Today this is widely accepted and used throughout the world. It has also been found to be a practical tool helpful for anyone involved in Self-Help personal studies.

On Tuesday, May 23 and Thursday, May 25, we will begin a 4-week exploration into the Enneagram, completing on June 15. In the first session alone, you'll find a significant increase in your understanding as to why you behave or respond to a situation differently than others in your life.

The class will be fun and valuable. I would like to offer one class, but if necessary, will offer 2. Tentative times will be either an evening class or a daytime class. When signing up for this, please indicate your preference for day or night class. Please also indicate if you CANNOT attend a daytime or evening class. The evening class will be held Thursday 6:30-8:30 PM. The tentative daytime class would be on Tuesdays, beginning May 23, 2:00-4:00 PM.

Please sign up early, as we will submit an order for the books on Wednesday, May 20. We will be using *The Essential Enneagram-the Definitive Personality Test and Self-Discovery Guide*, by David Daniels, M.D., and Virginia Price, PH.D (Copyright 2009, Harpers One, Publisher). The estimated book will cost \$12. We will also recommend *The Enneagram*, By Helen Palmer, and various websites. The 4-week series will cost \$50, and scholarships will be available on request.
